'For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways,' declares the LORD.

'As the heavens are higher than the earth,
so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.

Acts 7:8-10
Genesis 50:15-21
Joseph was the favourite son of his father; you are a F child of God
God had a D for Joseph's life and He has one for you
Joseph is a great example to us of 'A FB' and 'A FP'
God's ways are S to man's; He uses for our good T , T and even T
Joseph, like everyone of us, had an imperfect father, but we have a P _ Heavenly Father
Joseph learned the importance of C F F those who wrong us, for unforgiveness harms us and our relationships – Hebrews 12:15
Joseph tried to free himself from prison, but God's way was S God has promised if we trust Him, He will V us – Psalm 135:14
If we respond aright, our Fantastic Heavenly Father can use everything we experience in life for our ultimate G

What Satan and other people intend for our harm, God intends for our good and His G P Genesis 50:20
The course of our life's journey is often not what we would choose, but our Fantastic loving Father is more concerned with our C than our comfort and convenience
Like Joseph, the apostle Paul concluded that in A things God works for the G of those who L Him and whom He has C according to His purpose – Romans 8:28
